




Who We Serve — Top Diagnoses Treated at the MemorialCare Rehabilitation Institute

In 2024, 57% had neurological impairments, such as stroke, spinal cord injury, brain injury or other neurological conditions.

498 total patients were treated at the Rehabilitation Institute at Long Beach Medical Center in 2025.

The Rehabilitation Institute serves a greater population under the age of 65 years than other inpatient rehabilitation facilities in the region.





Where Our Patients Come From

Often, our patients are transferred from other hospitals because they require a higher level of specialty care. Of our admissions, 25% come from hospitals outside of our own medical center.

Most Patients Go Home — Not to a Nursing Home

We know that our patients' number one goal is getting back to their lives. At the Rehabilitation Institute, our therapists, nurses, and physicians have that same goal and will partner with patients to achieve it. In total, 83% of Long Beach Medical Center patients are discharged to their home and not a nursing home.

Patients Transferred From




Excellent Patient Experience
